WATER AND SEWER RATE INCREASES

Please be advised that water and sewer rates will be increasing effective October 1st, in accordance with Bylaw No. 6 – 2016

Water Rates: In town 6,000 gallons or less- \$116.00

Sewer Rates- Residential rate \$32.00

Water service deposit fees will be increasing to \$200.00 and re-connection fees will be increasing to \$40.00.

FALL WATER LINE FLUSHING
