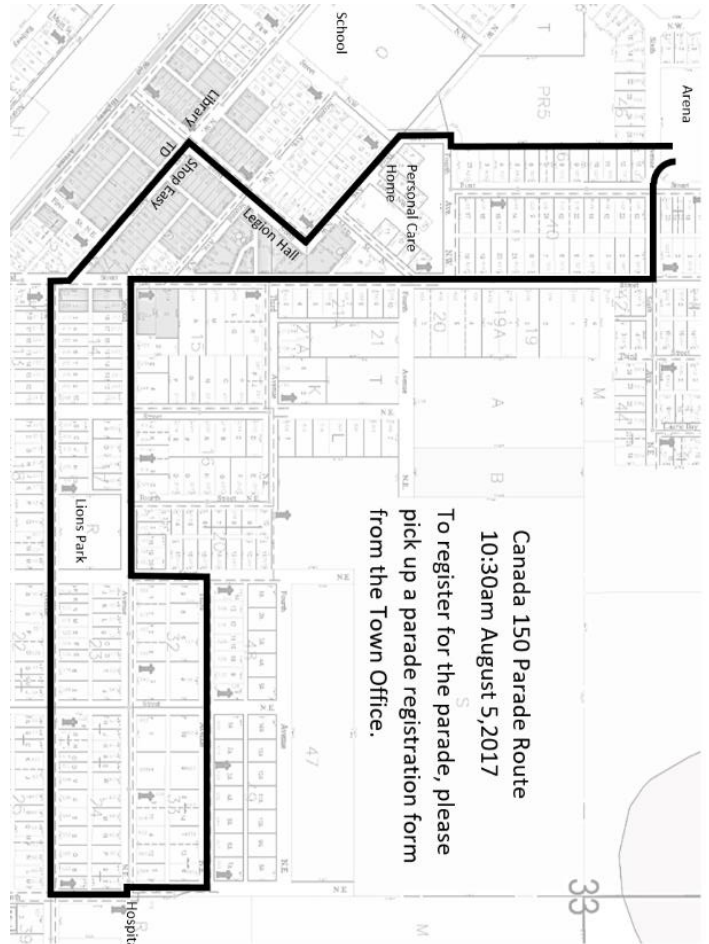

## GRASS CLIPPINGS

The Town of Preeceville would like to remind everyone to please avoid scattering grass clippings and yard debris on to the streets and sidewalks. Grass clippings and yard debris on the streets will cause the storm sewer drains to become clogged.

## ELM TREE PRUNING BAN

The Elm Tree Pruning Ban is in effect from April 1<sup>st</sup> through to August 31<sup>st</sup>, to prevent the spread of Dutch Elm disease. During this time, no pruning or removing of Elm trees is permitted within Saskatchewan. For more information on Dutch Elm Disease Control Regulations, contact 1-800-SASK ELM (727-5356).

## ANNUAL NOTICE TO CONSUMERS

The Town of Preeceville is required by the Ministry of Environment to provide water consumers with a drinking water quality and compliance report each year. This report states the quality of water produced and supplied by the town as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by the Minister's Order or Permit to Operate a waterworks. The Towns 2016 report has been compiled and is now available for pick up at the Town Office.

## FIRE PIT INSPECTIONS

Please be reminded, that as set out in Bylaw No. 9-2004, it is required of all citizens to get new fire pits inspected by the Fire Department.

## BUILDING PERMITS

The Town of Preeceville would like to remind everyone that development and building permits are required for most new construction projects and renovations to existing buildings. These permits ensure your project complies with the Municipal Zoning Bylaw and the National Building Code.
